DESCRIPTION AND OPERATION

DESCRIPTION OF FRONT END PANEL

The H Series front end panel is made of a molded, flexible urethane plastic. Since the panel is flexible it cannot be painted with acrylic lacquer.

Urethane paint and materials are especially made with a flexible conditioner so that the cured film will flex without cracking.

The front end panel on the A Series Regal is made of a one piece molded fiber glass panel. As when handling any panel, caution should be used to prevent damage.

The A Series Century, B, C and E Series use a metal front end panel.

MAJOR REPAIR

A SERIES CENTURY FRONT END PANEL EXTENSION REMOVAL AND INSTALLATION

A Series Removal

- 1. Remove radiator grille as per Grille Section.
- 2. Unplug headlight wiring and remove the 2 parking light lens assembly nuts, per each side, and pull assemblies out of way.




Figure 8D-1 H Series Front End Panel

- 3. Remove the nuts that attach the extension to vehicle, Figure 8D-4, and remove extension.

4. Remove headlight items from extension.

A Series Installation

1. Reverse the removal procedure for installation.

FRONT END PANEL REMOVAL AND INSTALLATION

H Series removal and installation procedure are covered in the 1975 Body Manual. Refer to Figure 8D-1, 8D-2 and 8D-3 for exploded views.

A Series Removal

- 1. Remove radiator grille as per Grille Section.
- 2. Remove the front end panel extension assemblies as per extension removal in this section.
- 3. Remove the panel to fender bolts, see Figures 8D-4 and 8D-5.
- 4. Remove the panel to radiator support bolts, see Figures 8D-4 and 8D-5.
- 5. Remove the panel and protect from scratching.

It may be necessary to loosen the front of one fender and pull outward to allow room for removal.

A Series Installation

1. It may be necessary to loosen the front of one fender

and pull outward to allow room for the panel to slide in place.

2. Reverse the removal procedure for installation.

B-C Series Removal

- 1. Remove radiator grille, and grille extension (per Grille section).
- 2. Remove panel to radiator support bolts see Figure 8D-8.
- 3. Remove panel to fender bolts see Figure 8D-7.
- 4. Remove the panel and protect from scratching.

It may be necessary to loosen the front of one fender and pull outward to allow room for removal.

B-C Series Installation

1. If panel will not slide into place it may be necessary to loosen a fender and pull outward.

E Series Removal

- 1. Remove radiator grille (per Grille section).
- 2. Remove panel to radiator support, and fender bolts. See Figure 8D-10.
- 3. Remove the panel and protect from scratching.

It may be necessary to loosen the front of one fender and pull outward to allow room for removal.

E Series Installation

- 1. If panel will not slide into place it may be necessary to loosen a fender and pull outward.
- 2. Reverse the removal procedure for installation.




Figure 8D-2 H Series Front End Panel Retainer




Figure 8D-3 H Series Front End Panel Ornamentation




Figure 8D-4 A Series less Regal Front End Panel Assembly




Figure 8D-5 A Series Regal Front End Panel




Figure 8D-6 A Series Regal Front End Pillar




Figure 8D-7 B-C Series Front End Panel to Fender




Figure 8D-8 B-C Series Front End Panel to Radiator Support




Figure 8D-9 B-C Series Front End Panel Ornamentation




Figure 8D-10 E Series Front End Panel




Figure 8D-11 E Series Front End Panel Ornamentation




Figure 8D-12 E Series Front End Panel Ornamentation
